

WHAT IS THE RESILIENCE FUND?

The Resilience Fund provides funding and wraparound support to help small-tomedium sized charities and CICs build their organisational resilience. This year, we will be making grants of up to £90,000 over three years for organisational development work.

Focus

Organisations that are working to build leadership skills in young people affected by racist or Islamophobic violence, empowering them to positively impact their own lives and the communities in which they live

Eligibility criteria 🗸

We are looking to work with organisations that:

- are registered charities or community interest companies (CICs) with an annual income between £100,000 - £1.5m;
- have at least one year of published accounts;
- cover and deliver in the areas where the Berkeley Group operates (see website for more details):
- be focused on building leadership skills in young people affected by racist or Islamophobic violence, empowering them to positively impact their own lives and the communities in which they live;
- be able to demonstrate that young people have a clear role and voice at every level of the organisation;
- apply for funding towards organisational development work and not frontline delivery;
- apply for funding over three years;
- request no more than 20% of their overall turnover in any one year;
- have a safeguarding policy in place;
- not have had support from Berkeley Foundation's Resilience Fund in the past.
